Sylvie Laurin lives and works in Quebec as a professional artist. She completed a bachelor's degree in visual arts, training in administration and a 2nd cycle in the study of artistic practice. Her committed remarks deal with social issues that concern her. Its production of unique pieces; sculptures, installations, body adornments, contemporary jewelry and ephemeral nature art aims to denounce, affirm, question and transmit a message that is both societal and environmental. She spent a stint in the financial sector as a securities broker specializing in ethical investments and green technologies. She realized after a few years that art would be a better revealer of consciousness, that she would reach a wider audience who would better serve her artistic purpose. This could be more global, impactful and satisfying for the artist.
